#### 1878

Milton Hershey creates his first candy company in a Philadelphia suburb. It then fails and goes under six years later.



#### 1886

Milton Hershey walks away from two unprofitable confectionery ventures. He starts a caramel company with chocolate covered caramel that becomes a instant hit.



## 1894

Hershey's cocoa is introduced by the company. It is the very first Hershey product that is available to the public. This is when the Hershey's brand is created.



#### 1900

Chocolate goes from being a luxury that only the rich could buy, to a treat that everyone can afford after Milton builds his factory.



#### 1903-1905

Milton builds a model town with a trolley system, houses, schools, and a zoo to provide his workers a better quality of life.



## 1906

Hershey park is built for employees and their families to make them happier.





#### 1907

Hershey's kisses milk chocolates are introduced. They were wrapped by hand in foil.



## 1925

The peanut filled Mr. Goodbar is invented. It was the first chocolate bar since the chocolate bar.



## 1926

Hershey's chocolate syrup is then invented. This then leads to the invention of chocolate milk.



## 1927

The first recipe for s'mores appears in the Girl Scout handbook using Hershey's chocolate bars.



### 1929-1939

Milton funds the "Great Building Campaign" in Hershey, PA. This puts 600 men to work during the great depression. The Krackle bar is also invented.



## 1945

Before Milton Hershey passes away, he gives his entire wealth to the company, town, and charitable schools and institutions.



### **NOW**

Hershey's continues to make new chocolate products and spreads happiness around the world.
